Ref: Safety Recommendation 20-00017

The Aircraft Accident Investigation Authority (AAIA) is an independent government agency charged by the Minister for Transport and Housing with investigating every civil aviation accident and incidents in the Bahamas. We determine the probable cause of the accidents and issue safety recommendations aimed at preventing future accidents.

On June 26th, 2019, the AAIA was made aware via its voluntary reporting system, of a pilot who landed his aircraft on a taxiway at the Leonard M. Thompson International Airport. The details of the resulting safety recommendations may be found in the attached report.

The AAIA has not received a response from BANSAs; therefore, the following safety recommendation classification compliance status has been issued:

SR20-00017 Closed - Unacceptable Action/No response received¹
