The Aircraft Accident Investigation Authority (AAIA) is an independent government agency charged by the Minister for Transport and Housing with investigating every civil aviation accident and incident in the Bahamas. The AAIA determines the probable cause(s) of accidents/incidents and issues safety recommendations aimed at preventing future occurrences.

On February 6th, 2019, the AAIA adopted its safety recommendation report reference Accident Report AO-18-000009 which occurred on June 5th, 2018 involving a Cessna 421B aircraft, Bahamas registration N421MM. The details of the related accident investigation and the resulting safety recommendations were sent to your Organization on February 6th, 2019.
