Ref: Safety Recommendation SR-19-0016

The Aircraft Accident Investigation Authority (AAIA) is an independent government agency charged by the Minister for Transport and Housing with investigating every civil aviation accident and incident in the Bahamas. The AAIA determines the probable cause(s) of accidents/incidents and issues safety recommendations aimed at preventing future occurrences.

On May 22nd, 2019, the AAIA adopted its safety recommendation report reference Accident Report AO-19-000016 which occurred on May 15th, 2019 involving a Piper Aztec aircraft, Bahamas registration C6-TIM. The details of the related accident investigation and the resulting safety recommendations were sent to your Organization on May 22nd, 2019.

Despite previous requests for an official response, the AAIA has not received any communication from Odyssey Aviation in response to the below issued Safety Recommendation. Therefore, the following status has been issued by the AAIA:
