The Aircraft Accident Investigation Authority (AAIA) is an independent government agency charged by the Minister for Transport and Local Government with investigating every civil aviation accident and incidents in the Bahamas. We determine the probable cause of the accidents and issue safety recommendations aimed at preventing future accidents.

On August 31, 2018, the AAIA adopted its safety recommendation report reference Accident Report A18-000002 which occurred on January 9, 2018 involving aircraft C6-MIC. The details of the related accident investigation and the resulting safety recommendations were sent to your attention on August 31, 2018.

The AAIA has not received a response to these recommendations and therefore have classified the safety recommendations compliance status as follows:

SR18-029	Closed - Unacceptable Action/ No Response ¹
SR18-041	Closed - Unacceptable Action/ No Response
