The Air Accident Investigation Department (AAID) is an independent government agency charged by Minister for Tourism and Aviation with investigating every civil aviation accident and incidents in the Bahamas. We determine the probable cause of the accidents and if applicable, issue safety recommendations aimed at preventing future accidents.

On 06 February 2019, the AAID adopted its safety recommendation report. The details of a related serious incident investigation and the resulting safety recommendations may be found in the attached report.

Among the Safety Recommendations are three of critical importance issued to the Bahamas Civil Aviation Authority, which can be found attached to the report.

The AAID is vitally interested in these recommendations because they are designed to prevent accidents and save lives. We would appreciate a response from you within 90 days, detailing the actions you have taken or intend to take to implement them. When replying, please refer to the safety recommendation by number.
